### Covid-19 Safety Planning and Policies

The Interdisciplinary Plant Group (IPG) and the University of Missouri (MU) are extremely committed to the safety and well-being of all participants of the IPG 2022 symposium “*Enhancing the Resilience of Plant Systems to Climate Change*”. We recognize that the circumstances surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic continue to evolve, and we cannot predict what conditions will be in Columbia, MO at the end of May. However, we will do all that we can to ensure the safety of all meeting attendees to host an in-person meeting.

At this time, we cannot provide specific details regarding the safety precautions that will be necessary to provide a safe, in person meeting environment in May. We will be updating registrants as the situation evolves and the meeting date approaches.

We also most strongly encourage vaccination for all in-person attendees as the most effective way to protect yourself and all other meeting attendees.

We are making every effort to organize the meeting activities to allow for social distancing and outdoor alternatives during events, when possible.
